**Argyll & Bute Council Cemeteries Consultation:** The convener reported that Argyll and Bute were proposing to support only four cemeteries within its bounds at Oban, Lochgilphead, Dunoon and Campbeltown. The Council are also wanting to divest their responsibility for cemetery maintenance, relying on the volunteer sector to carry out this function. The Committee agreed that Presbyters should be encouraged to engage in the consultation.
