Points for Prayer from the **Mission Committee.**

2. Pray for the successful implementation of our Presbytery Mission Plan

3. Pray for organisations, within the bounds of Presbytery, who provide support to tackle poverty.

Point for Prayer from the **Augusta Lamont Bequest Committee.**

The committee would invite Presbytery to pray for the success of the projects and in particular to pray for those people who may as yet not come to church but who could be encouraged to do so as a result of these Mission activities.

Points for Prayer from the **Ministry Committee**

- a. **Youth Work in Argyll and eXp Summer Camps in particular.**
- b. **Pastoral Care, that we identify a way to provide safe and effective pastoral**

care.

- c. **For Ministers who may be considering Argyll as a place to live and work in the future.**
